Issues and Fiscal Impact

Item Issues and Description

ldentified Salient Issues [*]	The South Third County Service District operates a sewer system serving about 41 customers South of Corvallis. The Board of Commissioners are the Governing Body of the district.
	The district has difficulty securing payment of delinquent accounts. Under the current process, accounts 60 days overdue are sent written notice by the Finance Department demanding payment. The collection method available under ORS 454.225 for sewer systems which lack another service that can be turned off (i.e. water) is OR 454.225 which provides that the Governing Body can certify delinquent accounts to the County Assessor for extension on to the tax roll for collection in a manner similar to a property tax levy. In this case only the specific property is assessed for the delinquency, not the patrons of the district in general.
	The accounts attached to the resolution are in excess of 60 days overdue. Each has been notified in writing of the delinquency and provided an opportunity to bring the account current. This is the annual process to secure payment of overdue accounts.

Fiscal Impact Description *	Collection of delinquent accounts will improve cash flow of the district and help postpone the need for future rate increases. The process negates the need to use County counsel in the small claims court process thus avoiding legal expenses and administrative effort.
